



TINA B. – THE PRAGUE CONTEMPORARY ART FESTIVAL

The **TINA B. Festival** is a unique art event, organised each year in Prague by Vernon Fine Art International. In October 2010, for three weeks Prague will again become the mecca of contemporary art. Like every year, the capital city of the Czech Republic will host a gathering of artists and art work from central and eastern Europe and other countries around the world.

TINA B. is an acronym for the English sentence 'This Is Not Another Biennial'. But the name 'TINA B.' also evokes the idea of a sensual figure – the festival's patron, a mysterious lady with an ever changing visage, attracting thousands of visitors to the Prague festival.

The festival has repeatedly been organised under the auspices and with the support of the Ministry of Culture of the Czech Republic and the City of Prague.
